**Earns Credits For Master's**

Mrs. Velma Ruhly of the Birmingham schools attended a Mathematics Workshop in "Individualized Primary and Elementary Mathematics" which was held at Dayton University the weeks of June 12 and June 26.

In addition to six hours of class and homework, evening seminars were held. Dr. Andrew Schott, Ph.D. of Milwaukee and Sister Felicistas of Dayton University were the lecturers.

Basic laws and principles in mathematics were studied. The use of the "Numberad" (tabaci) to develop understanding based on manipulation and discovery by children was thoroughly explored.

MEETINGS WERE held in the evening for people who would be conducting workshops as the summer progressed. Birmingham will have such a workshop in August.

Mechanics of organization involving materials and persons of varying backgrounds were considered, in addition to content coverage.

Oral and written examinations were given by the University at the completion of the Workshop. Three hours of graduate credit toward a master's degree were earned.

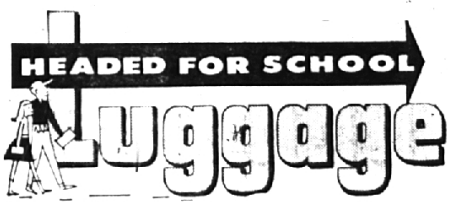

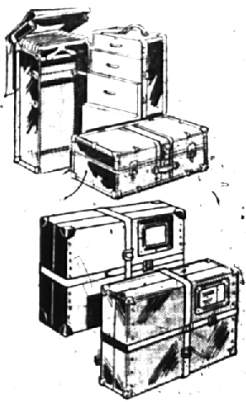
**CRANBROOK**—Not until Sept. 19 do Cranbrook students return to their books. Registration is Monday and Tuesday mornings.

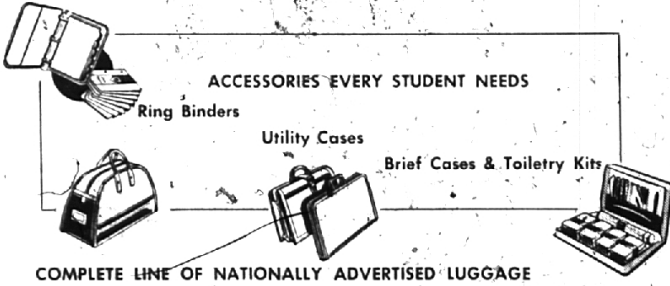
