



Conant Elementary to Open in Bloomfield Township

The new Conant school, built by the Bloomfield Hills schools, is located next to the Bloomfield Hills junior high school on Quarton road, west of Telegraph road near Wing Lake. The latest in school architecture, Conant is a one-story structure. It was designed by Tarapata and Mac-

Mahon. An elliptical shaped glass and plastic wing on the east side of the building and a square shaped tile roof over the gymnasium on the west side are unique features of the building.

Roof Repairs Cost \$5,700

Authorization of \$5,715 worth of roof repairs for Birmingham schools was voted by the board of education recently.

This is about the normal annual expenditure on roof repairs, Richard Featherstone, administrative assistant to the superintendent of schools, said.

The figure does not include replacement of slipping roof tiles on a portion of the Derby junior high roof. Featherstone said a decision on whether to proceed with this repair, which would cost about \$5,000 by itself, is awaiting a determination as to whether the slipping tiles are merely decorative or serve some necessary function.

APPROVED FOR repairs were roofs on Barnum junior high, \$160; Adams, \$550; Harlan, 180; Pembroke, \$160; Derby, \$260; Walnut Lake, \$825; Franklin, \$170; Valley Woods, \$84; Pierce, \$290; Greenfield, \$250; Beverly, \$265; Baldwin, \$160; Torrey, \$450; Quarton, \$988 for new gymnasium roof and \$750 for the remainder (total \$1,784); Bloomfield, \$150 and Seaholm, \$545.



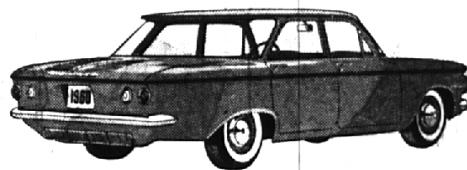
