19 Student Teachers Assigned to B'ham

Birmingham public schools, for the sixth consecutive year, will again work with Michigan State University on a cooperative teacher training program. Nineteen university seniors will arrive in Birmingham between Sept. 1 and 6 to begin 14 weeks of full-time student teaching. Eleven of these future teachers will work at the junior high and high school levels and eight will be assigned to elementary school classrooms, according to Marjorie Tate, coordinator of student teaching.

THE STUDENTS will live in or near Birmingham and will, by living the life of a teacher, find out what the job of a teacher is. They will participate in school athletic programs, faculty affairs, teachers' meetings, PTA activities, faculty study committees, conferences with parents and work with special school personnel.

Fence to Protect Younger Pupils at Walnut Lake School

Younger pupils at Walnut Lake school this year will be protected from wandering out of their play area into Walnut Lake road traffic by a new fence. It will run from the western side of the building to the west boundary of the school property and a short distance south.

There will also be a new hard surface parking lot for the school costing \$2,582.

Recommendations of landscape architects for additional fencing, another baseball diamond, a hard surfaced play area, grading and drainage control and shrubbery planting were not acted upon by the board of education.

BOARD MEMBERS said that development of other school sites and funds available had to be considered but that the additional improvements at Walnut Lake might be accomplished in the future.
