Civil Service Reports
On State's Job Scene

More than 3,000 persons resigned from state jobs covered by civil service during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960, and 190 others were fired, according to figures released recently by the state civil service commission.

The average monthly number of employees covered by civil service rules during the year was 22,811. The average monthly number of resignations was 2,811.

Franklin K. DeWald, civil service director, said an additional 210 persons were terminated from state employment by death or various other reasons for a grand total of 3,174.

In an analysis of persons leaving state service, DeWald said the major reason listed (852 cases) was to accept better positions outside state government, 471 retired and 465 left to continue their education.

IN THE CATEGORY of so-called "non-turnover" separations, DeWald said 118 persons temporarily appointed to "provisional" positions were replaced after open competitive examinations were given to the permanent employees.
