SCATTER SHOT

Perhaps it is a bit hot right now, but we still have to make our Christmas plans now. What would you like us to do in the way of lectures, demonstrations, gift merchandise, etc? A few tips may help us to make the season more exciting than ever for you.

The ideal time for developing or improving your lawn is here. The most important job is to FERTILIZE. This means to apply 2 lbs. of nitrogen to each 1000 sq. ft. You accomplish this by spreading 20 lbs. of 10-6-4 fertilizer on each 1000 sq. ft.

Then water once a week and make it deep—6 to 8 inches.

Then raise your mower to 2 inches.

Then knock out the pesky weeds.

Then seed bare areas.

Plant MADONNA LILIES now and get ready for the daffs, tulips, etc., which will begin arriving any day now.

Tie up cauliflower heads by pulling the leaves over the top and fastening with a TWISTEM.

Place a thin board or shingle under melon plants and wireworms will be thwarted.

Same for squash but remove the borers every morning.
