 into the Detroit sewer system.

SEWER INSTALLATION, in the undeveloped areas of the city which have not been subdivided, including a 44-acre project in the northwest corner and a few smaller areas scattered throughout the city, would be undertaken at a later date.

There are also two main developed areas of the city where there are existing sewers. These would not be replaced but would remain in service.

One area is located at the south end of the city bounded by Lone Pine and Highland drive. The other occupies an area between Long Lake and Vaughan roads.

Three subdivisions, Cranbrook - Quarton Road Estates, Lone Pine Court and South Cranbrook, are included in these two sections.

ACCORDING TO STADLER, an equitable adjustment as determined by the engineer and city commission would be made to the property owners along these existing sewers.

The sewers to be installed, said Fred Stryk of Hubbell, Roth and Clark, would have an estimated life of at least 40 years.

"Of course," he said, "there are sewers in Europe installed during Napoleon's time which are still in use. So you really can't tell how long sewers might last. Some are good for hundreds of years."
