Young Republicans' Chairman Calls for 'Alert Leadership'

The chairman of the Oakland county Young Republican club has called for "an alert and informed membership" to help carry the GOP to victory in Michigan in 1962.

Irene Giacobbi, 170 Roth, Clawson, told a meeting of the club's executive committee in Birmingham recently that the future of the Republican party in the state depends to a great extent on "how effectively we are able to draw dynamic young men and women into the GOP fold."

Miss Giacobbi cited the county Young Republican role in bringing in a GOP victory in Oakland county as "just a small indication of the potential groups like ours possess."

"If we ever faced a challenge it is now," she told the group. "Although the Republican party lost on the state and national levels, it displayed its greatest show of strength since the pre-depression era."

"We gained in both houses of Congress. We missed the White House and the governor's office by literally a hair's breadth. Now is the time to capitalize on our gains and maintain a position of strength for future elections," she declared.

Miss Giacobbi, who will step down as the club's chairman next month, urged the group to develop a long-range program of political

education for 1961.

THE EXECUTIVE board announced that the club's next general meeting will feature the film "Operation Evolution," considered by many authorities to be one of the best films on communism ever produced.

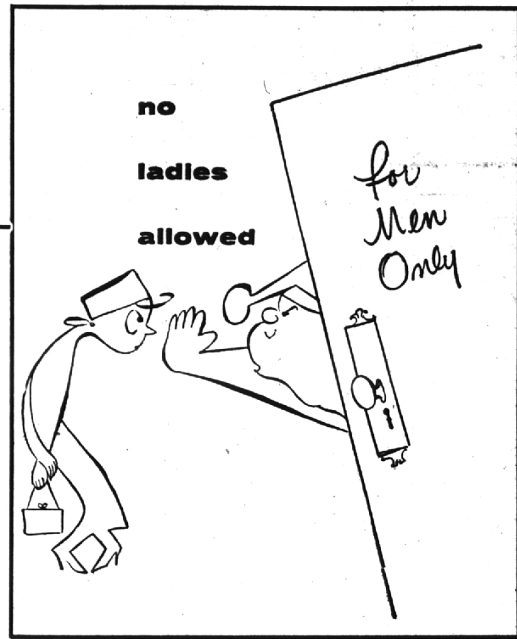
