Single Community Schools Foreseen By U of M Prof

By the year 2000, both Great Britain and the United States will have a single tax-supported secondary school in each community which will educate all the youth born and reared there. So predicts Warren A. Ketcham, (Ph.D.), University of Michigan associate professor of education, who lectured last semester at the University of Leeds on a Fulbright grant. "Each student, with help from parents and teachers, will select a program of studies to fit his abilities, purposes, and interests. "In the meantime, a large number of American school systems are going to dismantle hundreds of high school shops, home economics departments and art studios and re-establish them. High school bands and orchestras will disappear and reappear," he predicts.

"FOR 25 YEARS American

high schools have been experimenting with courses designed to meet the real needs of adolescents. Efforts haven't always been perfect but a lot of value has been learned.

"The secondary core of the American teaching profession is under attack and has lost heart," Ketcham says. "We have expected the American high school to do for the top 60 per cent of American youth what the British do for the top 20 per cent of British youth.

"NO BRITISH teacher, educationist, or citizen I met abroad made any pretense of saying that their top 20 per cent of secondary students educated in grammar and independent schools is academically superior to the top 20 per cent of Great Britain was 75 per cent. The British are concerned, especially in view of finding a high relationship between the age at which drop-outs rise and the rise of juvenile delinquency. Our drop-out

County GOP Funds Exceed Democrats

Oakland county democratic expenses and receipts listed on a report filed by Committee Treasurer Louis H. Golden with county Clerk-Register Daniel T. Murphy, Jr., fell far below the amounts claimed by county Republicans for the 1960 election campaign.

According to the democrats they collected \$21,117 and spent \$11,216 in their campaign to capture some of the county offices.

Contributions reached a record high for the Republicans who collected \$187,651 according to GOP County Committee Treasurer Chad M. Ritchie.

AMONG THE DEMOCRATS' seven entries of receipts were \$5,184 from a membership drive, \$5,171 from the annual "Dollars for Dems" drive and \$5,210 from the fall congressional dinner.

Democratic congressional candidate James G. Kellis received \$1,930 from the county committee from September through November according to Golden's statement.

Kellis' campaign to unseat Republican incumbent Congressman William S. Broomfield was also aided by union contributions according to his personal campaign expense account.

KELLS SAID HE received a total of \$5,100 and spent \$4,000 with \$1,400 contributed by the county AFL-CIO council and \$500 from the UAW regional office in Pontiac.

Broomfield's account listed only \$1,000.
