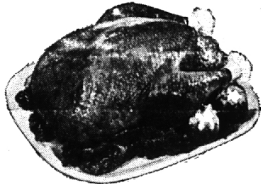

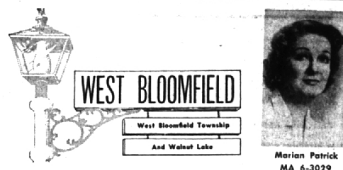

Newcomers Celebrate Daughter's Birthday

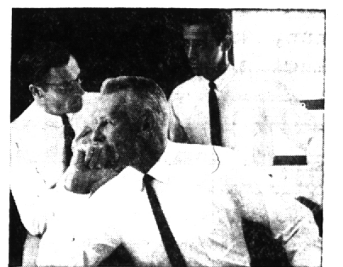

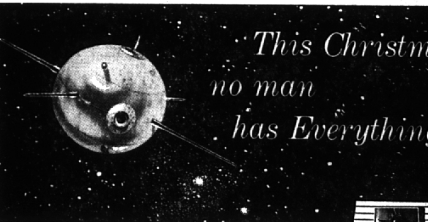
