Wood Creek, Planners Joint Meeting Dec. 15

WOOD CREEK FARMS - The council referred three matters for planning commission study. Tuesday evening meeting for or a joint meeting to hear recommendations.

Major interest to residents is a request by developer George W. Smith to have a large outlot at 15 Mile and Northwesters returned to commercial. Although Smith implied by letter that the property might be used as a site for a funeral home, without destroying the residential character of Wood Creek, President Alger Clark stated that once the status of property is changed to commercial it would be subject to a specific type of business. At present, Wood Creek has no commercial zone.

Along with planning commission and council consideration, the matter will require approval of the zoning board.

roads from Maple to Cranbrook over.

5. Bradway from Maple to Overhill.

6. Glengarry road from Bradway to Ambery.

7. Cranbrook Cross from Willingbury to Covington; Cranbrook road from Covington north including the Pine Street intersection; Pine Street from Cranbrook to Westwood drive.

8. Covington from Maple to Ambery.

9. Waddington and Westwood from Tibury to the Tibury road intersection.

10. Oak from Covington to Yarmouth.

STREETS that would be improved in the second year includes: All streets in the area between Maple north to Birmingham and from Lahser east to Hupp cross.

2. All streets in the area between Maple north to and including Bradway and from Hupp cross east to Hamilton; Hamilton from Chertow Cross to Bradway.

3. Cranbrook cross from Maple to Willingbury; Willingbury from Cranbrook cross to Glengarry circle.

4. Glengarry road from Cranbrook cross to Bradway.

5. Glengarry circle; Glengarry road from Ambery north to Quantan; Ambery from Glengarry road to Covington.

6. Covington from Ambery to Quantan.

7. Yarmouth from Tibury place to the village limit.

8. Cranbrook road from north of the Pine intersections north including Dorstone and Tottenham.

9. Tibury place from Yarmouth to Tibury road; Tibury road from Tibury place to Pine.

10. Waddington from Pine to Yarmouth.

11. Oak from Yarmouth to the village limit.

12. Glengarry drive from Maple to Pine; Pine from Westwood to the village limit.

REALIZING A 234 per cent increase in road income from state gas rebates, Wood Creek's council approved a road budget revision to use \$1060 of these additional funds for paying fall ditching bills.

Mrs. Lam and councilman Norman Kriss were assigned the task of finding a polling place for the village election in March. The Wood Creek Civic association will be asked to nominate candidates for the office of village president and two council posts so that petitions can be filed with the village clerk, Mrs. Alice Billis, on or before 4 p.m. Feb. 11.

Mrs. Vernor Gets \$160,000 Settlement

BLOOMFIELD TOWNSHIP - Mrs. Shirley C. Vernor Friday received \$160,000 of the settlement of the estate of her late husband, James Vernor Jr.

The share was from \$2,350,000 Woodbank drive, was discovered sold since her husband died in 1957. Mrs. Vernor lives at 707 W. Long Lake road, Bloomfield township.

THE SETTLEMENT was approved by Circuit Judge H. Russ Holland and provides that the remainder of the stock proceeds go into a trust fund for Vernor's two children by a former marriage, Gracey Shannon Vernor, 19, and James H. 20.

Mrs. Vernor originally claimed a lifetime share in the stock which was sold under court order. In addition to other things, Mrs. Vernor owns a 78-acre estate in Bloomfield township.

She is survived by her husband, an advertising executive; two daughters, Judy Lee and Kimberly Anne, both at home, and her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Omer McClung of Taylorville.

Services were held at the Bell chapel, William R. Hamilton funeral home Friday, Dr. Arnold F. Rinkel of the First Methodist church officiated. Interment was at Taylorville.
