Director of the group is William Casey, music teacher at Brookside school, Cranbrook.

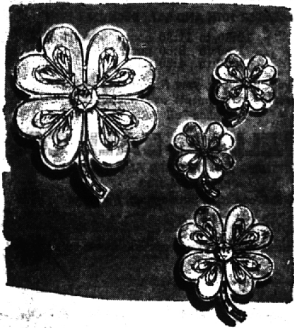

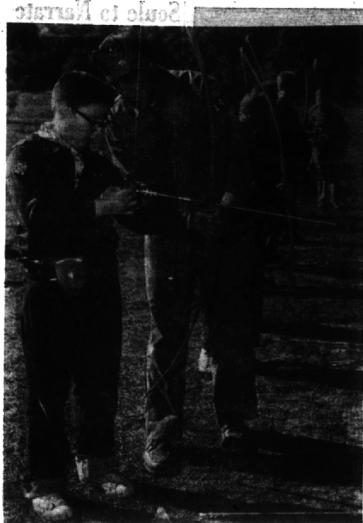

## Adams Seeks Own Recount

Probate Judge-elect Donald E. Adams, who defeated State Senator L. Harvey Lodge by 694 votes, has filed a counter petition for recount.

Lodge demanded a recount of 90 precincts last Monday.

Among the 55 precincts Adams chose to be recounted are 21 in South Oakland. Recount of the 55 precincts will cost him about \$275.

Canvassers will recheck vote totals on machines in the recount. In his petition Lodge alleged errors by election workers who took totals from the machines and transferred them on paper.

It will be about another week before recount is completed.

Hyde told police he was traveling about 20 miles an hour on westbound Maple. Police attributed the accident to Tuesday's light snow.

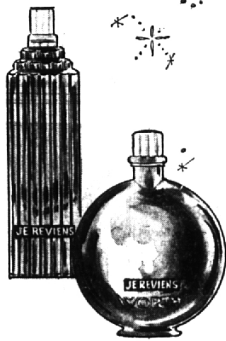
## Area Schools Visited

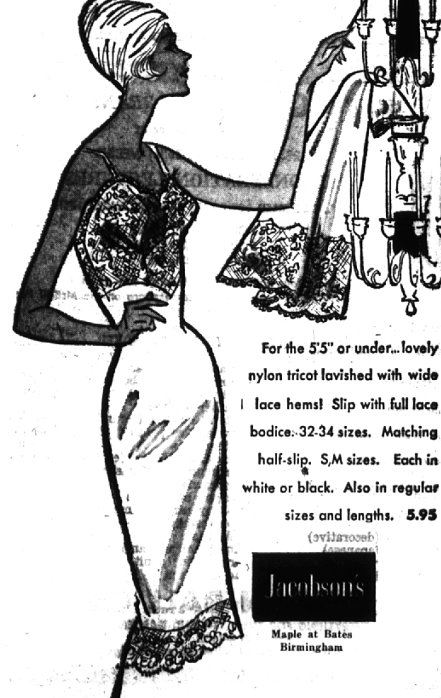
