Franklin Interiors of Franklin Village has established an interior decorating service as part of an expanded operation to serve the public in individual furnishings for the home.

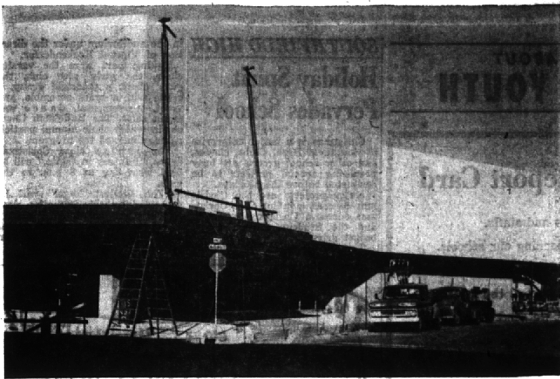
