SUCH AN answer might cause such confusion in a Spaceman's mind that he'd leave us immediately.

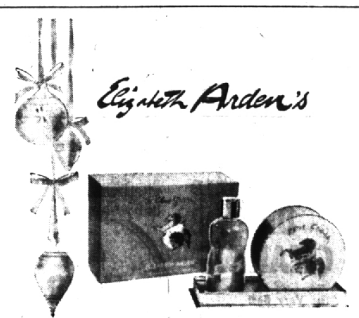
If history book might be scanned, we'd have a delightful time in attempting to explain the small number of years this earth has been at peace.

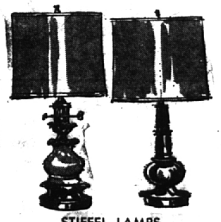

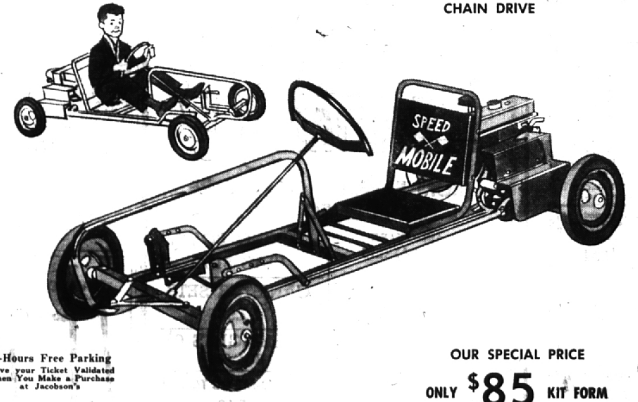
