

## Typing Classes Will Be Held In Southfield

SOUTHFIELD — After school beginner classes in electric typing will be held at Birney and Lederle Schools beginning Jan. 16 and 17. The classes will run Monday, Wednesday and Friday of one week, alternating with Tuesday and Thursday in the following week.

The one-hour classes will be held for 23 weeks for a total of 52 hours and are open to children in grades three to nine.

Registrations will be accepted by the principals of each school in the Southfield school district or by a member of the typing committee. Registrations must be in by Jan. 6. A deposit must accompany each registration.

SATURDAY classes for beginners will be offered at the two schools for grades six through nine. The 40-hour course will con-

sist of two-hour lessons. Also offered are speed classes for any student. The 20-hour class course will be held in one hour sessions.

Evening classes are being considered for adults and older students if sufficient interest is shown. The course would be 52 hours long and total 52 hours.
