Mrs. Kelley Balks On Extending Easement Rights

LATHRUP — "I want a deal all the way round," Louise Lathrup Kelley replied to council queries Monday night when asked whether she was prepared to extend right-of-way easement beyond a Dec. 31 deadline.

The easement is on Kelley-owned property along the Evans ditch and would allow the city to lay sewer lines across the property to connect with the Evergreen Interceptor.

City administrator Jerald Stone was directed to do whatever was necessary to start construction on the easement before the deadline in order to protect the city from loss of the easement right-of-way.

The city is under court order to construct a sanitary intercepting sewer by July 1, 1961. A contract awarded Monday night to the low bidder, Giannetti Brothers Construction Co., will probably not be executed before the easement right-of-way expires, the council said.

Woman, Daughter Hurt in Accident

BEVERLY HILLS — A Beverly Hills woman and her 11-year-old daughter are reported in satisfactory condition at William Beaumont Hospital where they were taken following a three-car accident Friday night at Woodward and Chapin, Birmingham.

Mrs. Margaret E. Barlow, 88, suffered a compound fracture of the right knee and lacerations on the face. Her daughter, Jane, suffered a fractured jaw and multiple lacerations. They live at 15589 Buckingham.

Mrs. Barlow was driving south on Woodward when her car was struck at 6:04 p.m. by a vehicle driven by Thomas Zika, 52, 23010 Golfview, Southfield. Zika's car then hit the rear of a car, marked on Chapin and owned by Harvey F. Trombley, Royal Oak.
