### Residents to Vote On Pay Increases For Councilmen

SOUTHFIELD — City Council billed the pay of four officials last week and at the same time put pay increases for city councilmen on the primary ballot to be voted on by residents Feb. 20.

Raises for the mayor (from \$2,000 to \$3,000), clerk and treasurer (\$7,500 to \$8,500), and judge (\$8,000 to \$8,500) will become effective April 10 when the new term of office for these positions starts.

Request by the council would raise their pay from \$20 to \$25 per meeting and remove the charter limit of \$200 which can be earned in one year.

The present council used the sum in July and has been meeting without pay since Aug. 1.

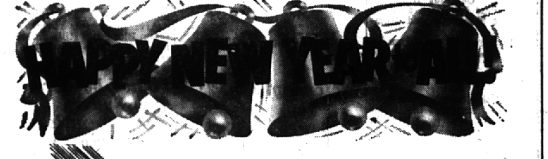
