Local Youths Attend Alcohol Study Meeting

Several cars will carry local high school students to Lansing on Saturday, Feb. 20, to join the state Youth Advisory council for a Youth and Alcohol workshop.

Dr. Lynn Bartlett, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, will address the morning session. Dr. George Maddox, Millaps college, Jackson, Miss., and Dr. John J. Pascutti, state supervisor of alcohol education, Vermont, are being

sent to this workshop by the National Institute of Mental Health, U. S. Public Health service.

DR. MADDOX has conducted several studies of teen-age drinking in the U. S. Dr. Pascutti has directed workshops for educators at the Yale university summer school of alcohol studies. The first of its kind, the Youth and Alcohol workshop is sponsored by the Michigan Youth commission, State Board of alcoholism, and the Department of Public Instruction. Members of the state Alcohol Education committee (the 19 members of which include Eugene L. Johnson, Superintendent of Schools, Bloomfield Hills, Mrs. Rosalee McGaffey, Birmingham resident who is a visiting teacher in Dearborn, and Carl Zwinck, Birmingham) and others will meet with the outstanding teenagers who are members of the Youth Advisory council, on Feb. 19. Following a dinner meeting, plans for the workshop will be completed.
