projects shortly after estimates were made and the rolls were prepared—before cost changes had a chance to happen.

A saving of approximately five per cent seems to be the current average, according to figures submitted to the city commission at Monday's meeting.

The one deficiency reported was on the repaving of Frank street, from Woodward to Ann.

ESTIMATES here were made without the benefit of construction drawings, Sorenbetz said, since the engineering department was not given sufficient time to make them.

The Lakeside resurfacing from Midland north to the bridge showed a surplus of \$200. Original estimate was \$3,300.

The paving of Holland east from Eton to the Grand Trunk railroad siding cost \$2,585 less than the originally estimated \$12,000. Cost cut here costs 20 per cent might be attributed to the project's inclusion in a contract for a larger job and the fact that bids were taken at different time of year than the others.

COST of paving Ann from Lincoln to Landon, and Landon from Ann to Woodward, was \$104,108 less than the original estimate.

A refund of \$3,517 on the paving of the Maple-Bates alley is being held up while the city investigates claims of Eugene A. Moore, owner of the Moore building that the paving caused water leaks into the building's basement.

Original estimate on the project was \$54,400. The actual cost was \$50,883.

Shopping Center Defeated In Heated S'field Meeting

SOUTHFIELD — The proposed Southfield shopping center "S'field" was defeated by a 4-3 vote Monday when nearly 400 residents thronged to the Southfield council meeting.

The proposed nine-acre center, at the southeast corner of 12 Mile and Evergreen came under fire from residents, most of whom live in the Cranbrook Village subdivision north and east of the center site.
