New Federal Route Signs Are Colorful

LANSING—Installation of temporary red, white and blue interstate route markers has started on some 200 miles of interstate expressways now open to traffic in Michigan.

The expressways are part of the 41,000-mile national interstate system of defense highways authorized by Congress in 1956.

STATE HIGHWAY Commissioner John C. Mackie ordered the installation of the temporary signs in the interest of acquainting the motoring public with new route designations and a rather surprising widespread public acceptance and even demand for the interstate route markers.

"It's indeed an encouraging sign that highway users seem ready to assimilate the change in route numbering," Mackie said.

Expressways now open and affected by the order are portions of US-12 which will become Interstate 94; US-16, which will become Interstate 96 from Detroit to Grand Rapids and Interstate 196 from Grand Rapids to Muskegon; and the Detroit - Toledo Expressway, and a portion of the Pontonopline and US-27 Expressways now open to traffic.

UNTIL THE ROUTES are completed from border to border, current plans call for a dual type signing to acquaint the motorist with the new designations and still retain former designations with which the motor public is more familiar.

When the routes are completed, the old US markers will be removed.

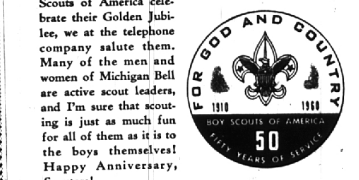
