In recognition of his sales achievement, Frost will receive a \$50 U. S. Savings Bond from the Lincoln-Mercury Sales Council, Coll said.

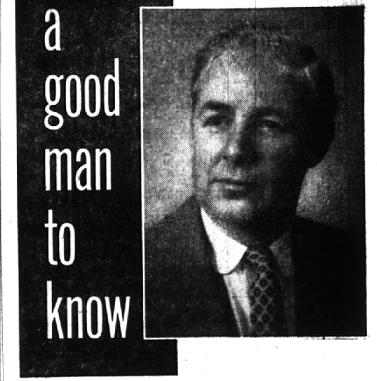
Frost also will be eligible for district, regional and national "salesman of the year" award.

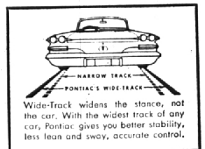
