27-Year-Old Seeks State Senate Seat

Donald E. Barber, 27-year-old White Lake township resident and member of the Oakland county Young Republican club, recently announced his candidacy for the Republican primary nomination for Oakland county state senator.

Discussing his campaign, Barber said, "I hope to be able to talk with each Oakland county citizen regarding their preferences for better Michigan government."

"I will emphasize and encourage that each citizen should have an active interest in state government and that as an elected state senator from Oakland county I would serve each Oakland county citizen in the Michigan legislature."

A Michigan state university graduate and Air Force veteran, Barber has been leader in the Young Republican organization. He worked as campaign assistant to Paul D. Hagwell in his 1958 gubernatorial campaign.

Rep. Roberts Won't Seek Re-Election

State Representative Farrell E. Roberts announced today that he will not seek re-election to the office of state representative from the third district, Oakland county.

He added that he, as present, is not planning to seek any other elective post this year although he intends to keep an active interest in government.

Representative Roberts, now in his second year, serves chairman of the Labor committee, vice-chairman of judiciary committee, and member of the committees on revision and amendment of the constitution and marine affairs.

Zigmund Niparko To Make 4th Try For House Seat

His intention to run for Congress was announced last week by Zigmund John Niparko, of Hazel Park, Niparko, who made three previous tries for the Democratic nomination in 1950, 1956 and 1958 primaries, is a teacher in the Ferndale school district.

In making his announcement, the 39-year-old Hazel Park civic leader said, "I think Oakland county is not represented fully because it does not have a Congressman who is a member of the majority party in Congress."

Niparko will be opposed in his bid for the Democratic nomination by another school teacher, Edward J. Vanderlaan, 4901 Valley Vista, Troy. Vanderlaan teaches at Southwell high school.

Broomfield Cites Waste In Offices

(Editors Note: Recently Ferd M. Broomfield, local realtor, communicated with Congressman Wm. S. Broomfield relative to the expensive new Senate and House Office buildings in Washington, D.C. Mr. Broomfield received an answer from Congressman Broomfield, who was contented to allow The Eccentric - to reprint most of it, as follows.)

Dear Mr. Broomfield:

Certainly, the vast building program now being undertaken by the Federal government is a case of point. I am sorry to say that much of this new construction is a direct product of Congress. Right across the street from my offices, a third House office building is now being constructed at a cost between \$60 million and \$84 million, depending upon whose figures you want to use.

These office buildings for U.S. Representatives is an outrageous waste of money and space. There are many Federal agencies which are in dire need of just plain room of any sort, without constructing a Taj Mahal to perpetuate an ever-growing bureaucracy in the legislative branch of the Federal Government.

A second Senate office building, just recently completed, is another case of wasted money to the tune of some \$50 million. This building is needed as badly as a hole in the head. It is true that we have added our share of Senators, but I cannot see where office space for these Senators should cost the taxpayer approximately \$15 million apiece.

My best wishes, and I will continue to fight wasteful Federal spending at every opportunity. I am afraid this is going to be a difficult fight until such time as we are able to elect a Congress which has more regard for the taxpayers' pocketbook, but I will do what I can.
