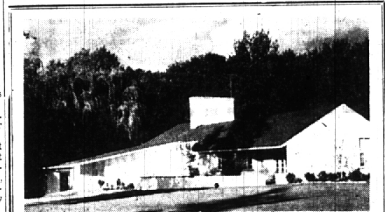
Boys in Blue and Gold To Be Honored Feb. 29

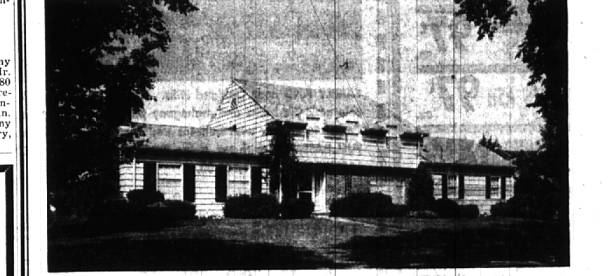
