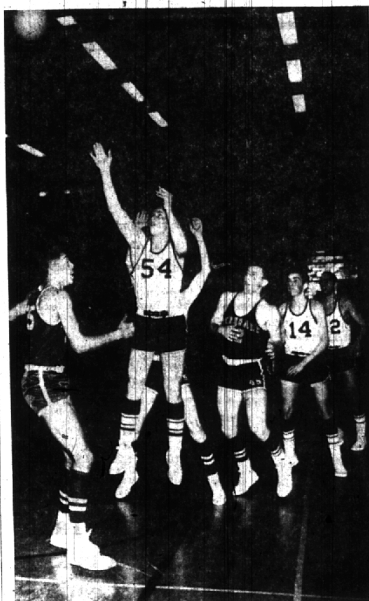


Rek Cage Loop Needs Coaches

She said insurance company attorneys will handle the Summers' defense.

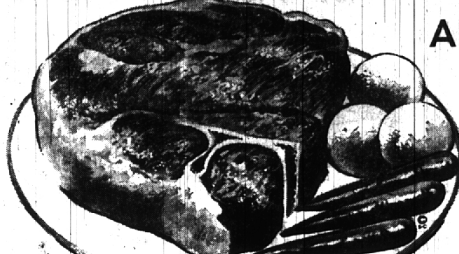
