**Plant Manager Accepts Award**

**Local Investors Purchase Five Apartment Buildings**

Snyder, Kinney & Bennett, Inc., Birmingham realtors, announced completion of the sale of the Birmingham Woods Apartments building at 323 to 361 North Eton road, to a group syndicate of local investors.

The sale was made in that it involved almost 1/2 million dollars and the development of an investors syndicate organization requiring elaborate legal documentation. Emery, Parsons and Bahr, 1100 North Woodward, handled the legal details, and the sale and syndicate development was accomplished by H. D. Anderson, vice president of Snyder, Kinney & Bennett, Inc.

According to Elliott S. Kinney, president of the firm, who has been active in the real estate field since 1936, this transaction appeared to be the largest, unproved property sale ever known in the Birmingham-Bloomfield Hills area.

Built by Joseph Milgrom, and completed in September, 1959, the group of apartment buildings in-

clude 40 two-bedroom apartments, fully air-conditioned, with 1 1/2 baths each, together with all modern built-in kitchen equipment, as well as refrigeration and disposal units. All apartments are heated individually by gas. Rentals range from \$135 to \$145.
