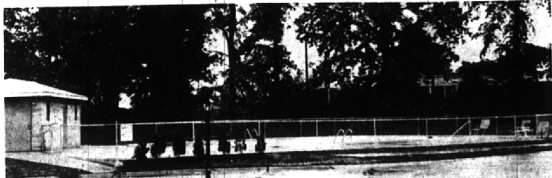

Earnings Hit Record High

The Detroit Bank and Trust company reported net operating earnings for the first six months of 1960 were \$5,190,882, equal to \$2.82 a share. This compares with net operating earnings of \$4,232,338 or \$2.30 a share for the first half of 1959.

This represents an all-time earnings record for any first half in the bank's history. The announcement was made by Joseph M. Hodges, chairman Birmingham has three Detroit Bank and Trust branches.

Loans showed an increase in each category and were up \$110,086,998 from a year ago to a total of \$450,038,700. Loans and discounts were \$303,979,190 compared to \$290,960,002 at the same time in 1959; and real estate loans were \$146,059,509 up from \$132,991,600 as of June 30, 1959.

Total deposits were \$865,761,967 on June 30, 1960. Demand deposits represented \$473,775,015 of that figure. Savings and time deposits were reported at \$388,986,952, a gain from \$376,416,043 a year ago.

E. Wright Yount, 591 Rudgate, Bloomfield Hills, vice president in charge of sales, said that AMP, which for 25 years has been a major supplier to the automotive industry, is currently expanding its service to car makers.

"We are investing money in new facilities and personnel for our automotive section to meet the steady expansion we feel is due in the industry in the next three or four years," he said.

AMP has enjoyed a substantial share of the automotive parts market for many years and intends to bid strongly for more by keeping abreast of the latest developments in research and manufacturing," said Yount.

The company recently announced it is spending more than \$6,000,000 for additional facilities to produce truck axle housings.

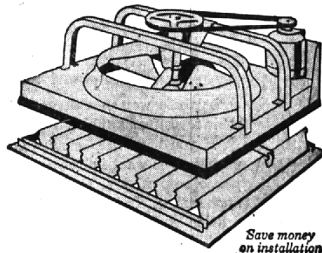

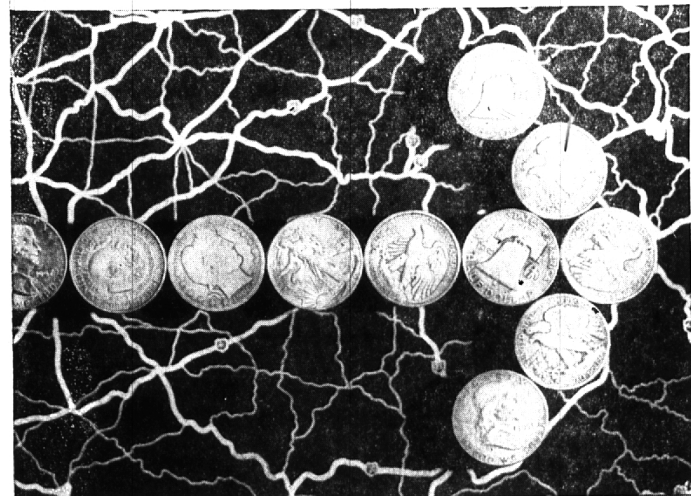
