**Teen Delegates Describe Trip**

Our recent trip to Miami was an experience we will never forget. Our first stop was at the Detroit Fisher Branch of the YMCA where the Michigan Delegation to the ninth National H-Y Congress met. On the following day we departed by bus at 7:45 A.M. for the Miami University campus, Oxford, Ohio. The National H-Y Congress meets once every three years. (This year was a "first" in that 50 states were represented.) Its purpose is to elect new officers, to pass legislation effective for the forthcoming three years, and to promote the unity and strength of the National H-Y Fellowship.

Not all of our time was spent working. Time was allotted for dancing, swimming, bowling, cards, etc., and to meet as many as possible of the 800 representatives.

The program consisted basically of speeches by Dr. John Oliver Nelson, Professor at Yale Divinity School.

Following each daily program we met in groups of about 20 delegates to discuss his speeches. The discussions continued in small groups of friends. Other discussion topics were segregation and dating. There was no prejudice of race, color, or creed at the congress.
