Offer Film On Politics

"Where Were You?," a new Ford Motor Company motion picture about U. S. political parties and elections, is being premiered in approximately 50 cities throughout the country beginning this week.

The first of the premieres, sponsored by Ford community relations committees, was in Canton, Ohio, July 12. In the Detroit area, previews will be held in Witom, July 22; Ypsilanti, July 29; Highland Park, July 31, and Birmingham and Monroe, July 26.

The film is available free for showings by television stations and civic, fraternal, church, school and other organizations.

"Where Were You?" is a 28-minute, 16mm. black-and-white film narrated by Joseph N. Welch, noted jurist, attorney and television commentator. The film portrays a typical election and demonstrates how the apathy of many persons enables a few to dominate politics and elections.

The film also explains how political parties choose candidates.
