Instead of having their drivers' licenses suspended as Bloomfield Police Captain Walter Sluiter had planned, Robert C. Barrell, 17, William E. Lintinen, 16, requested setting their own punishment. Switching from offenders to judges, the miscreants "smeared" themselves to paint the south half of Teowbridge bridge on Trondheim near Woodward.

THE SENTENCE was carried out in light lanes of cement gray Tuesday afternoon, an ideal day for swimming. "The rest of the bridge will be left for the next youngster who gets into trouble because he has no much time on his hands," said Sluiter. Sluiter said the multi-colored "bridge" has been the target of young amateur painters for the last year. "The bridge is not a hang-out," he said, "and I hope parents will discourage their youngsters from congregating there."
