Nottingham Forest Subdivision Opens

Birmingham developers Jack Andrews and Paul Briggs announced the formal opening of Nottingham Forest subdivision just west of Lahser on 14 Mile road. As Beverly Hills' newest subdivision, the ultimate 250 lots development occupies 114 acres of Oakland County's last virgin timber area. The developers have spared these awe-inspiring Oak, Beech and Maple giants, some of which are 350 years old, to preserve the grandeur of the natural beauty of the property. Birds, wild flowers, squirrels, red foxes and all the things one finds in unspoiled nature exist in

abundance. Lots with a minimum of 100 feet at the building line have been cleverly laid out to afford minimum traffic at any given point and to take every advantage of the views of the verdant valleys that interlace the property. 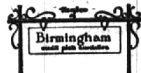
