New Apartments Underway

Residents Eldon G. Wolcott (left), 18377 Warwick, Birmingham, a local realtor, and associate Dee M. Kennedy (center), 31387 W. Rutland, Beverly Hills, are congratulated by William Hayward, Mayor of Royal Oak, for the ground-breaking of Oakland county's first cooperative apartments. The milestone in local history began Tuesday by the breaking of ground for the first of 14 buildings comprising 56 two-bedroom leisure living units. This brings to the North Woodward area for the first time, luxury-type living in a medium price range just under fifteen thousand dollars. Wolcott says these units were developed because of the high demand of many senior citizens, small families, and retired people who want their own home but want freedom from responsibility of care. Wolcott, who has many years of service in real estate in this area, believes this will be the beginning of a new concept of living for hundreds of families here. He points out that these developments can up-date cities by making higher and better use of land and at the present time requests for such homes are far greater than available land can support.
