TAKE NOTICE that a Public Hearing will be held by the Village Council of the Village of Beverly Hills on August 15, 1960, at 8:00 P.M., in the Village Office located at 18500 W. 15 Mile Road in said Village, for the purpose of considering the following changes, amendments and additions to Ordinance No. 29, being the Zoning Ordinance:

1. To create a new Zone District allowing multiple dwellings on certain sized tracts of land and requiring certain area, height, bulk and placement regulations for such principal use.

2. To change from Residential 1 Zone use to said multiple dwelling use the following described property:
