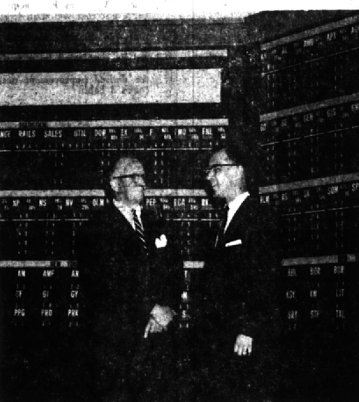

Hills Man Accepted

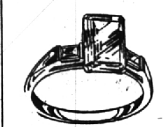
