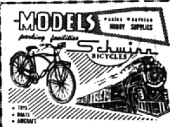

crime PUNISHABLE BY BOTH FINE AND IMPRISONMENT for a property owner, when approached by a realtor or other person to withhold intended sale of his property or even to inquire as to the color or race of the prospective purchaser.

"This law has been enacted in Massachusetts, Connecticut, Colorado, New York, and Oregon. It was introduced in 13 state legislatures (including Michigan) last year and would have passed in Rhode Island except for the vigorous opposition of a great constitutional lawyer (Robert E. Dresser) in Providence. Watch for it in the next session of your legislature."

THESE SO-CALLED civil rights bills have been introduced in the last four sessions of the Michigan state legislature and were not only retained in committee each time. Knowing Michigan politics, one can imagine what would have happened if they had reached the floor.

Understanding this, one can readily see how the "screening process" provided not only a convenient SMOKE SCREEN but also a cause celebre to discredit Congress. Pointe and to cause fair-minded people unwilling to join in a conspiracy against themselves.

The newspapers have seized upon those aspects which could be easily distorted in order to "scare the people" thus furthering the possibility of legislation that would be restrictive even to the newspapers themselves, for these bills contain a clause regulatory as to the mentioning of race, color, national origins, and religion in the press.

I feel confident that when the ulterior motives of the pressure groups behind this attack are widely known people everywhere will rally to the cause of those who are trying to protect their constitutional rights of property.

**Another Reaction On 'How to Run Our Schools'**

THE BUILDING of schools is an industry much bigger than the taxpayer with a limited point of view realizes.

As for a shortage of teachers, the Michigan Education and the National Education Association have exact statistics that can be obtained by writing to them.

Mrs. Belchambers implies that all the students in our school lack character. Has she checked to find out what the churches of the community are doing for our young people?

Has she done any research to note what percentage of our student body succeeds in colleges and universities throughout the land? We should not judge all students by the misdeeds of a minority.

THE STATEMENT that teachers work only 8 1/2 months as compared with 12 1/2 months in industry is quite unfair as there is a great difference in the aims and incentives of the two. Industry is interested in producing goods to make money and profits.

Incidentally, successful academic achievement in college does not necessarily mean that the superior student will be a superior teacher. Many persons with average grades have developed into the most devoted and best teachers.

Teachers are fortunate to have professional organizations such as the Birmingham Education Association, and the National Education Association to protect their rights as individuals which is one of the

privileges of a representative government.

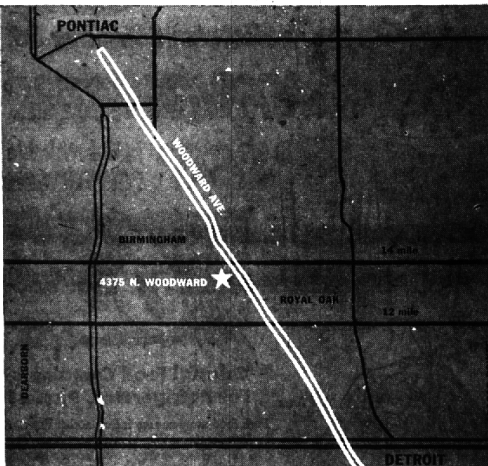
