### City Makes It Official: No Zoning Change

Terming it "apoc zoning", Birmingham city commissioners officially declined to rezone a Southfield avenue residential property to a non-retail business use.

Several months ago, the commission agreed with the city plan board's recommendation that the rezoning be denied. Property owner A. L. McNaughton asked for a formal hearing, Monday night, the commission turned down McNaughton's petition, 5-0. Two commissioners were absent.

McNaughton intends to construct a dental clinic at Southfield and Townsend.

COMMISSIONER Carl F. Ingraham appeared to sum up commission sentiment when he pointed out that professional men have plenty of available vacant already-zoned business property to buy for clinics.

He said there is no need to start a new business area and surround it with residential property.
