Vehicle Safety Check Best Yet, JC's Say

The recent automobile safety check in Birmingham was the most successful in the history of the program here, according to the Birmingham police department and the Junior chamber of commerce, co-sponsors of the event.

Final totals show that 1,291 cars and trucks were inspected June 4 and 11 by the Jaycees.

FIFTEEN per cent of all cars checked were defective. Forty-six per cent of the defective cars had malfunctioning head lights. Thirty-four per cent of all defective vehicles checked had malfunctioning brakes, and thirty per cent of the defective vehicles that were safety inspected had defective tail lights.

The 1960 vehicle safety check program was supported by Mayor Florence Willett's designation of Ireland as Vehicle Safety Check month in the city of Birmingham. Two safety-check lanes were operated in convenient locations where motorists were offered free safety checks on the 10 major stems of their cars which affect safe driving.

Honor Ireland With Dinner, And Citations

Special honors are coming faster as the tenure of Dr. Dwight B. Ireland, Birmingham's superintendent of schools drawn to its 7th I close. A surprise "farewell" dinner was held last week in a Detroit restaurant. Approximately 65 members of the administrative council were present to say "good-bye."

SEAHOLM high school Principal Ross Wagner, who has worked with Ireland for 17 years, presented the Irelands with a chandelier for their Washington Courthouse, Ohio, home. An album containing pictures of the council members was also presented. The board of education and the recreation board passed resolutions honoring the man this week.

THE BOARD of education resolution cited the "vision and guidance under which two high schools, a junior high school and seven elementary schools were built." CITY OF BIRMINGHAM ORDINANCE NO. 563 AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 527
 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3.3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 527 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, AND THE ZONING MAP, BY ADDITION OF A SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 3.3-17.
 THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM ORDAINS:
 Section 1. That Section 3.3 of Article 3 of Ordinance No. 527, be amended by addition of a section to be known as Section 3.3-17, said Section to read as follows:
 Section 3.3-17. Property located at 566 and 568 Ann Street described as lot #6, Assessor's Plat #15, shall be changed from its present classification of R-4 Multiple-Family Residential Zone District to B-1 Non-Retail Business Zone District.
 Section 2. The Zoning Map attached to Ordinance No. 527 shall be deemed modified to incorporate this change.

 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3.3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 527 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM AND THE ZONING MAP, BY ADDITION OF A SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 3.3-16.
 THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM ORDAINS:
 Section 1. That Section 3.3 of Article 3 of Ordinance No. 527 be amended by addition of a section to be known as Section 3.3-16, said Section to read as follows:
 Section 3.3-16. Property located at 560 Ann Street described as Lot #4, Assessor's Plat #15 shall be changed from its present classification of R-4 Multiple Family Residential Zone District to B-1 Non-Retail Business Zone District.
 Section 2. The Zoning Map attached to Ordinance No. 527 shall be deemed modified to incorporate this change.
