Alan P. Carlin, 211 Williamsbury, is one of 181 American and Canadian students who today will receive Ford Foundation foreign area training fellowships. Those are given for scholarly training related to Asia, the Near East, the Soviet Union, Eastern Europe, and Africa. Carlin, a graduate student at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, is studying South Asian area studies, with emphasis on Indian economic development. The fellowships are part of the foundation's program to improve American understanding and competence in foreign and international affairs, particularly in areas where knowledge and trained personnel are scarce.

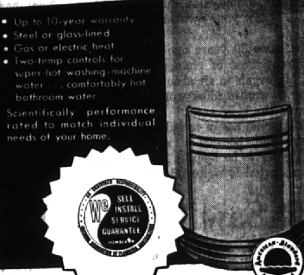
