Graduated in Lake Forest, Ill.

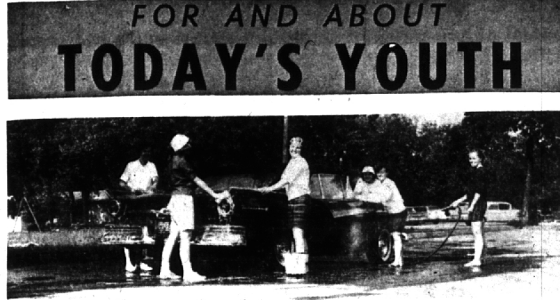

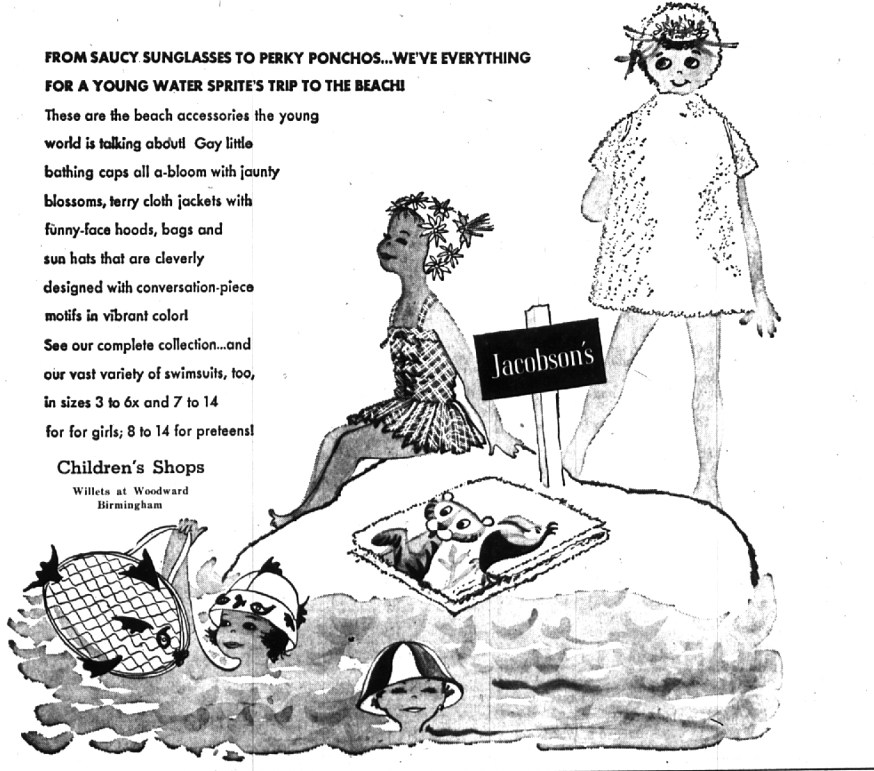
