## His Corvair Styling Wins Honor

The 600-member Industrial Designers Institute—the nation's oldest and largest group of industrial designers—announced in Chicago the award of the 1960 IDI Gold Medal to William L. Mitchell, General Motors vice president in charge of Styling Staff, and to his GM Styling Staff for the design of the Chevrolet Corvair. Shown with Mitchell who lives at 644 Hamilton, Bloomfield Village, is a model of the Corvair and the IDI medal—the only one awarded this year for an automotive design from among a large number of entries. The accompanying IDI citation praised Mitchell and GM styling for answering the challenge to create a truly new car by taking "a step forward in the development of a small, rear-engine American automobile." It declared that the Corvair has "finely-scaled proportions" and is "a satisfying design solution" to the demands of its market.
