justice under the city charter in December, 1955. He was re-elected in 1956.

A well-run and highly cooperative police department make the major for the justice whose prime motivation is that of helping and understanding the people who come before him.

"BY MAKING them feel at ease and free to talk, defendants often realize their own guilt," Losey went on.

"I try to talk to them without ridiculing the people who come before me. A stiff fine is often reduced in court," he said.

His philosophy seemed to be paying off last year in some fields.

"WE HAD ONLY one repeater among juvenile cases last year," the experienced justice said. Most of the juvenile cases are minors.

"IT DEPENDS on the person and his attitude, of course," Mason said.

"In general, though, we find the people who come to court cooperative," Mason went on.

Mason has been a township justice for almost 10 years and committee man for Boy Scout troop T-13 (Poppleton school) for 15 years.

THE TWO POSITIONS, he feels, permit him to make some judgments on the juvenile delinquency problem.

"There is no actual problem in Troy," he said. "And there would be much less juvenile delinquency if there were more juvenile courts."

Between arraignments and the issuing of warrants, Losey still manages to perform about one marriage per week.

THE REST of his cases are traffic offenses and violations of Troy's "disorderly" ordinance.
