

# United Negro College Fund Appeal Set

William T. Gossett, 420 Goodhue road, Bloomfield Hills, continues as steering committee chairman as the United Negro College Fund prepares to open its 17th annual appeal for funds which opens April 5.

Gossett, vice president and general counsel of Ford Motor Co., is a member of the National Council of the UNCF.

LOUIS G. SEATON, general chairman has announced that Mrs. Haley Bell and Dr. DeWitt T. Burton have been appointed co-chairmen of the campaign.

Richard H. Cummings, vice president of the National Bank of Detroit has been named treasurer of the campaign by Seaton, who is vice president-personnel staff for General Motors.

At a luncheon in the Sheraton-Biltmore, Seaton outlined plans for the 1960 fund appeal and emphasized that donations to the UNCF aid in the education of 25,000 students in the 33 Negro colleges which are members of the fund.

HE POINTED OUT that 40 percent of these students receive aid of some sort from the UNCF, although the average student in the 33 colleges finds it necessary to earn half of his own tuition and expenses.

Seaton asserted that the colleges are 90 per cent self-supporting, "but we are trying to raise the vital 10 per cent which will lift them above a subsistence level and enable them to operate more effectively."

He declared that none of the schools receive any public funds. "They are absolutely independent institutions," he added.

# DOWN TO EARTH Plant, Force Indoors Until Spring Comes

This is the time of year when gardeners are susceptible to any reason for getting their hands in the soil. It is too early to plant seeds for the outdoors but you might like to have some fun with plant material indoors.

For instance you can secure lily bulbs and force flowers indoors. Those which will force indoors are the golden chalice, rainbow and fiesta hybrids. Plant a bulb in a pot with rich humus soil, water well, and place in a dark location for two weeks or until you see a healthy stub begin to show itself about one inch above the soil, then place it in the sun. Stake the plant if necessary and enjoy its dividends.

YOU WILL want to plan at this time a group of lilies which will give you flowers from May until September. Select a sunny or half-shady location which has a good drainage and won't be in a high wind area.

For best eye appeal plant in groups of three or five, and at least five, 20 inches apart. For a fairly summer interest plant the golden chalice hybrids which are gold and yellow and the white and white candium category which will grow four feet high. Do try the variety Mega which is lemon color with mahogany spots.

FOR MIDSUMMER spectacular developments examine the category known as Bellingham varieties with their bright colors. Fiesta hybrids will give you tones from yellow to red. The mid-summer hybrids come in tones of yellow and red, with interesting markings.

The lily in August seem to be the varieties which will grow tall. So plan on them being low feet New York Flower Show were Mrs. Paul McConkey, Mrs. W. R. Farrington and Mrs. Frank Knight.

We all feel like authorities on flowers, the current threat season, the Guguzubium macrum and the United Nations. You will have a report on the expedition later from the horticultural point of view.

Bob, a graduate student, is playing Armand Desroches in the show, and is active in the University Theatre.

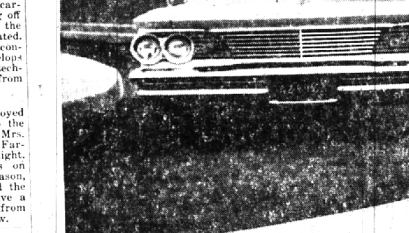
