**PTA Members Discuss Taxation, School Financing**

The Quanton school PTA held a meeting March 7 which took the form of a panel discussion on taxation and school financing.

The panel, consisting of Bennett Root, secretary, Birmingham board of education; Dr. William G. Gibson, superintendent of schools, Oakland county, and moderator Robert O'Rourke, legislative chairman, Quanton PTA, discussed taxation and school finances, including the proposed Birmingham school millage increase which will be on the ballot March 28.

**CHARTS WERE** displaying showing the need for additional teachers in Birmingham schools and the need for increasing salaries in order to remain competitive with other schools in the area. Root urged the parents to support the proposed 4 mill tax increase for schools to take care of this need.

Dr. Emerson cited statistics to show the increased load on the school system over the past ten years. He explained the operations of the county equalization board and the county tax allocation board.
