SO Symphony Orchestra Presents 'La Boheme'

The South oakland symphony orchestra, directed by Henri Nusco, will give their next concert 8:15 p. m. March 26 at Oak Park high school auditorium.

A concert version of Puccini's "La Boheme," sung in Italian with outstanding soloists, will be presented. The part of Mimì will be sung by Marilyn Cotlow, soprano, of Detroit.

MISS COTLOW, formerly leading soprano with the Metropolitan, created the original "Mimì" in Menotti's opera "The Telephone" on the Broadway run of the show. Her Columbia recording is the only opera recording to have sold over a million copies. Rodolph, in 1952, is Richard Miller, tenor, a graduate of the University of Michigan and now a professor of voice at the school. He was a Fulbright scholarship winner to Italy in 1951. He made guest appearances in opera, concert and radio all over Europe, and last year sang with the San Francisco Opera.

MARJORIE Gordon, lyric coloratura soprano of Detroit, sings Musetta. Formerly with the New York City Opera Co., she has played leading roles with other companies and appeared with major symphony orchestras, radio, television and motion pictures. She is now the general director of the newly established Detroit opera theater. John Bedford, baritone of Detroit, sings Marcello, a painter, and Irving Rosenkrantz, bass baritone, also of Detroit, is Colline, a philosopher. Albert Shant, bass, has a European background, but now lives and studies in Detroit. He sings two different roles, the Count, landlord and Alcindoro, an admirer of Musetta.

SCHAUNARD, a musician, will be sung by Gerard Durocher, baritone, from Windsor, Canada.
