**Men's Shoes
Are Lighter
And Brighter**

Men's leather shoes are marching in a more leisurely rhythm this spring, according to the Shoe Fashion Service of Leather Industries of America. The great increase in leisure and leisure clothing has inspired an abundance of new casual footwear in light airy leathers and bright spring and summer shoe color.

White is the most striking spring and summer shoe color. Washable white leather, usually in a distinctive pebble grain, is used on casual tie styles and slip-ons. White, in either washable or suede or brushed leathers, is also combined with brown or black in both casual and dress-casual shoes.

THE BROWN leather colors new this spring include: hawthorn, a darkish brown shade usually seen in grain leather; dark oak, a blackened brown with a subtle bronze undertone; maverick, a medium brown with a very slight greenish undertone; gaucho, a cool tan to-harvo tone, especially popular combined with white; American burgundy, a deep cordovan that goes with almost any color.

Slip-ons, once limited to the unlined moccasin, today are seen in shrunken grain leathers. Casual weekend slip-ons have moc toes with raised stitching limited to the vamp or traveling on back to the heel.

Town slip-ons are seen with plain toes or in moc-front styles in which the stitching forms a flat reverse seam — plated-down effect that goes well with the restrained styles in business and casual apparel.

Dress-shoe honors are divided between moc-fronts and wing-tips, and in both styles the emphasis is on lightness.
