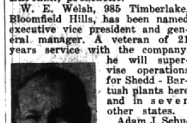


Explain Complicated Plans

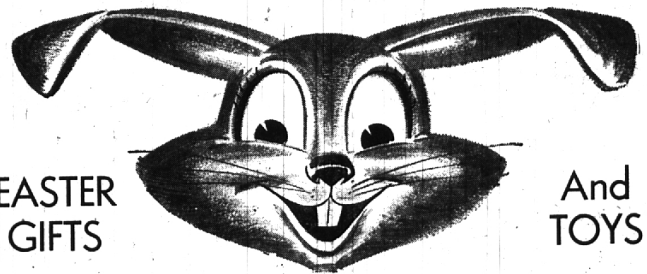

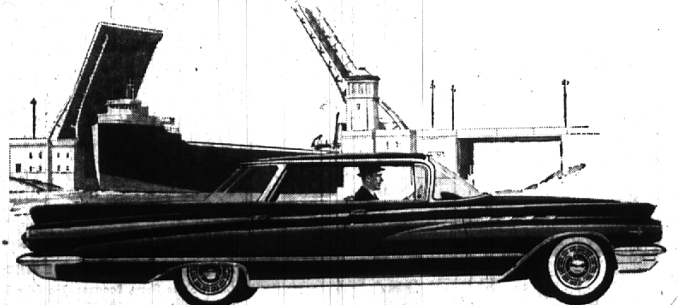
