**Years at Cranbrook Win Founders' Medal**

CRANBROOK—Sanford Holt Allen, accountant for the Cranbrook foundation since 1928, was the recipient of a Founders' medal April 29 at a ceremony in Cranbrook house, home of the late George G. Booth and his wife Ellen Scripps Booth, Cranbrook founders.

With music as an accompaniment, Allen has composed several songs, and for many years has been organist at St. John's Evangelical & Reformed church, Detroit.

HENRY SCRIPPS BOOTH, youngest son of the founders and chairman of the board of trustees

of the Cranbrook foundation, made the presentation, which included this message:

"Over thirty years the financial affairs of the Cranbrook Foundation have been kept in splendid order by one man with an eagle eye, an alert mind, a delightful sense of humor and a genial, cooperative spirit akin to the harmony he produced each week on a church organ."

"In recognition of his outstanding service to the founders' purposes through the Cranbrook foundation and the six institutions they established at Cranbrook, and in appreciation of all that he has done for us through those beneficent corporations,

"Be it resolved, that award is hereby ordered of the Founders' medal to Sanford Holt Allen, accountant, counselor and friend of Cranbrook."
