trusted friends always ready to enjoy the escapes away in the darkness.

"Uncle" Levi and his good wife continued their help during the long years in which the question of slavery raged, in spite of endangering their own safety and their business, which was first "cutting pork" and later the manufacture of linseed oil.

ALTOGETHER, it is believed he aided more than 3,000 of the fugitives to make their escape across the Ohio into Canada, where they found large tracts of free land on which to settle.

Many times the slave hunters threatened to kill "Uncle" Levi and there was a price on his head, but he persisted, declaring he felt no condemnation for his actions.

"If by doing my duty and endeavoring to fulfill the injunctions of the Bible, I injure my business, then let the business go. As to my safety, my life is in the hands of my Divine Master, and I feel that I have His approval," he said.

"It is supposed," the article concludes, "that the Coffins were none other than the Simson and Rachel Holiday, the Quaker couple alluded to in the famous book, 'Uncle Tom's Cabin'."
