Now there are numerous establishments that exist to teach them how to use the equipment and the technique that result in safe underwater swimming. Sports divers and their clubs constantly strive to make the sport safer, for swimmers, with their new found freedom underwater, are not always able to set up a pattern of safety for themselved.

THIS PATTERN of safety can be related to a certain degree to the individual divers' knowledge of his own physical condition, his equipment and the correct use of his equipment.
