Franklin Firm Adds to Staff

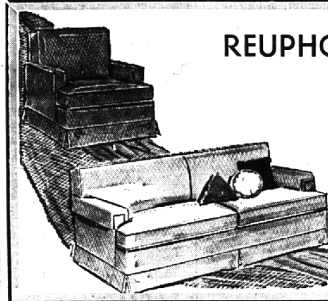
