DOWN TO EARTH Gardening Relaxes Busy Suburbanites

Your writer just called on a friend and she said: "You know how busy my husband is—we just can't get our place looking nice. It is very discouraging and I am worried about not being able to have the garden look nice right away."

My reply was, "Come on, now, enjoy this gardening in your yard. I will tell you how I can be very busy in my yard. (I know my friends will give me the "tazzerberries.")"

Number one, change your gardening attitude. Your garden is a beautiful area. You go to it when you want to relax mentally and sort out your thinking. Choose one specific flower bed and ten feet long along the grass frontage.

THE FIRST THING you do is use your edger and make the chosen area look nice along the grass line. Have with you a basket, pruning shears and your favorite cultivator. Now work to make that specific area look well groomed. It might take ten minutes. It is a job we will do every week. It is the eye of the casual gardener which will take care of the garden. You know that 70 per cent of them do a lot of "beans" about Mrs. Frchse gardening.

Now make an intermission and go inside to accomplish some routine tasks. Keep those trips to your garden as the "icing on the cake" for your hours of the day. Remember your garden is your "little heaven" and if you let it upset you the benefits it can be lost.

"GOING EVEN" a step further, you might like to survey your garden area and decide which spot looks the worst. Now, have that area, the spot which gets the emphasis for the season. If you follow this idea enough years, you will be delighted with the total effort, a series of spots in your garden with personality.

By the way, this week you should be sure that all of your trees, shrubs, evergreens, and perennials have been fertilized. For this spot, fertilizing you use a bucket with a handle or borrow. Take a kitchen sauce pan with a handle and make a circle with the fertilizer on the ground. Pour out the rains washing the fertilizer into the soil. If you dig it in you will harm the roots.

PLAN ON PLANTING your Easter Lily in your garden in a sunny spot. You will probably have another lily in the early fall. If you do not receive a lily, you can't expect good results in your garden. It is true you will have leaves, but it is rare to receive a variety which will produce flowers outdoors regardless of what the salesman told you. By the way, when you are buying...
