

Just the Recipes For Easy Meals

After home improvements are complete, there comes a time to enjoy them. And the improvement that's the most fun is an outdoor grill.

It can be a grill with frills or one that's just a clearing bordered by stones. The results are what count.

A meal prepared in your yard with fresh air as its condiment can complete any day with Epicurean's favorite taste-treater.

Try a few of these easy recipes during the next few months:

FOILED POTATOES

Slice potatoes. Layer on aluminum foil. Dot with butter, salt and pepper slightly. Seal tight in foil and lay on coals to cook at their own rate.

BARBECUED RIBS

Put ribs on foil. Baste with the following sauce: Cup of ketchup, 1 t. horse-radish, salt, freshly ground pepper, 1 t. of lemon juice or wine vinegar, 2 t. of sugar and a 1/2 t. of Worcestershire. Just baste till brown.

GRILLED BEEF PATTIES WITH SAVORY SAUCE

One pound of ground beef, salt and pepper, 1/2 cup cold water, 1 T. salad oil, 1 t. vinegar, 1 T. ketchup, 1 t. prepared mustard, 1 t. Worcestershire, few drops Tabasco sauce, 1 t. sugar, 1 small clove garlic chopped (or 1/2 t. of chopped onion).

Combine meat, seasonings and water, mix well and form into patties. Broil for 5 minutes.

Then combine remaining ingredients and simmer for 5 minutes. Spread over patties and broil on second side for 3 minutes.

WILTED LETTUCE SALAD

Take an appropriate amount of leaf lettuce. Wash, drain, break. Add 1 medium chopped onion, 1/2 cup mayonnaise, 1/2 cup vinegar, 1/2 cup sugar, 1/2 t. salt, 1/2 t. pepper, mayonnaise to mix. Rub bowl with garlic. Alternate layers of vegetables and

one clove garlic, 2 cups diced, cooked green beans; 2 cups diced, cooked carrots; 2 cups diced celery; 2 cups sliced, sliced; 1/2 cup cubed, sliced; 1/2 cup lemon juice; 1 to 2 t. salt; 1/2 t. pepper, mayonnaise to mix. Rub bowl with garlic. Alternate layers of vegetables and

Windows of Metal Give A Home Life

In planning home modernization, consider the advantages of replacing your old windows with modern metal.

Metal window types now widely available include casement windows, awning windows, which swing open from the bottom, and the double-hung type, which slide up and down.

These metal window types are designed to provide maximum light. With minimum frame, they would last as long as the building.

A common complaint against windows in older homes is that they are too small and too cluttered to let the room to give adequate light and air.

A good example of a problem is a window which makes a picture window.

Remember to include the size of the window in your remodeling plans. The bright view of the outdoors makes the kitchen a more pleasant place to work in.

Windows can be safely opened up for picture windows when a lintel is installed in the opening to carry the weight.

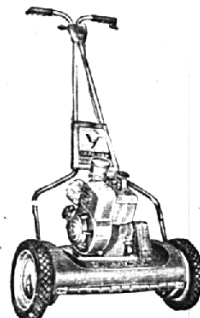
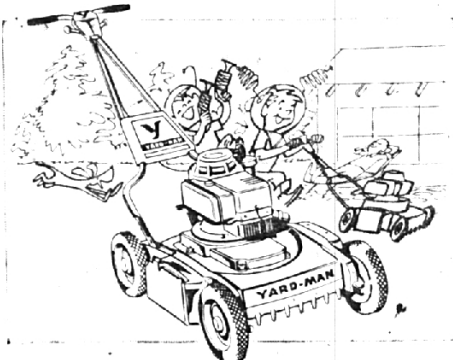

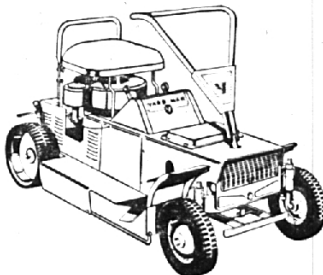
